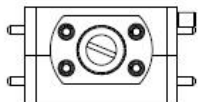

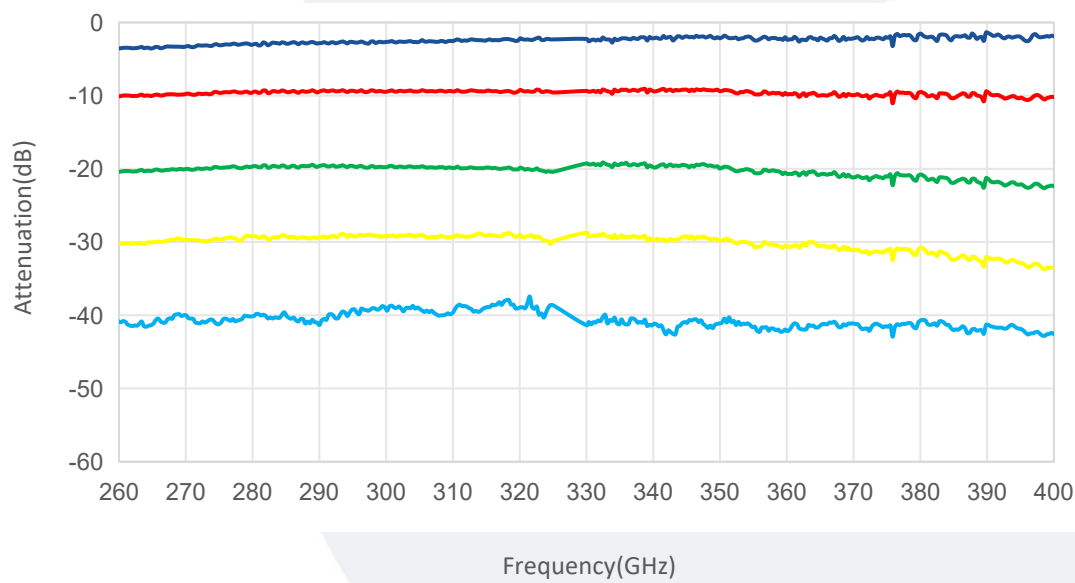

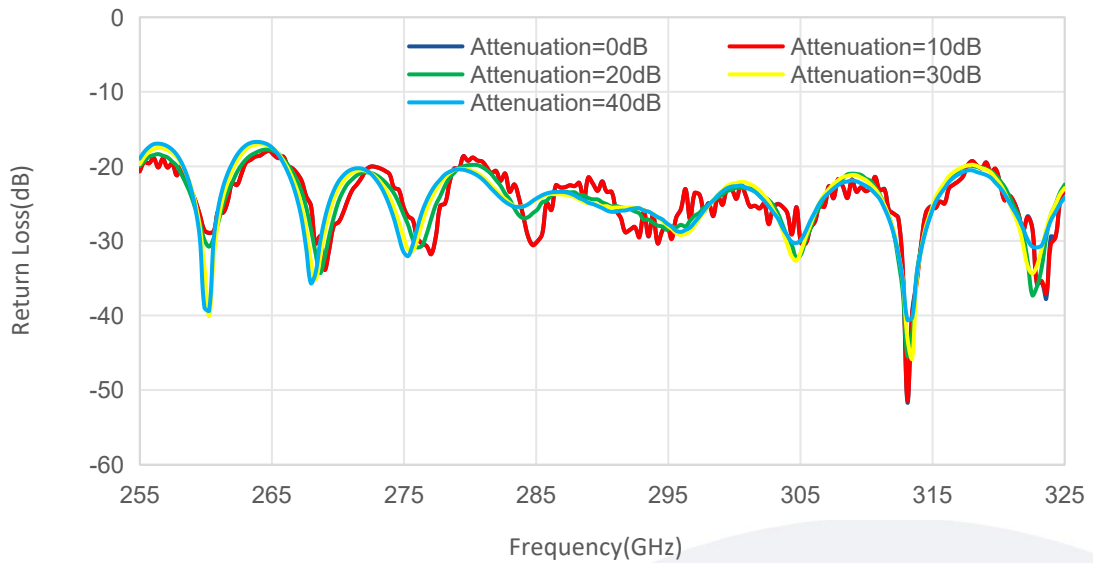
Attenuation vs Frequency
